 - a. Coordinated Entry

 - b. Built for Zero (formally Chronic Homeless)
 - PIT 1/24/22 from 3PM to 3PM on 1/25/22. Street count to occur 7PM to 10PM on 1/24/22; law enforcement agencies and fire assisting. Utilizing Google Doc as opposed to link as in previous years.
 - c. Membership, Ed & Public Relations
 - Perkins reaching out to DeKalb community for membership. 13 existing organizations missing paper work; must complete documents annually even if agency paid for multi-year membership. Two (2) new

organizations from Rockford joined: Second First Church and Family Peace Center.
